THE BEACH CONTROL ACT

THE BEACH CONTROL (LICENSING) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1999

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Natural Resources Conservation Authority by section 18 (1) of the Beach Control Act, the following Regulations are hereby made with the approval of the Minister:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Beach Control (Licensing) (Amendment) Regulations, 1999, and shall be read and construed as one with the Beach Control Authority (Licensing) Regulations, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations) and all amendments thereto.
- 2. The heading and regulation 1 of the principal Regulations are amended by deleting the word "Authority" wherever it appears.
- 3. Paragraph (2) of regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting the words "five hundred" and substituting therefor the words "one thousand".

4. The principal Regulations are amended by deleting the Second Schedule and substituting therefor the following—
