

Extract of Regulations for Protection against Fire.

1. No person shall permit to be stored or deposit in any yard, open space or any land in his possession or occupation any combustible material without the consent of the Council.
2. No person shall set, kindle, or permit to be set or kindled fire in any open space or on land in his possession or occupation, situate within a radius of three miles from the Kingston Parish Church.
3. No person shall erect or cause to be erected on any land in his possession or occupation any building or structure wherein it is intended to use fire without obtaining the consent of the Council so to do. Any person desiring to obtain consent shall apply to the Council in writing submitting proper plans in duplicate of such building or structure and such consent may be agreed to on such terms and conditions as the Council may think proper.
4. No consent under Section 3 shall be given if the granting of such consent is likely to cause danger from fire or nuisance to the public or to any owner or occupier of the adjoining land.
5. No person shall set or kindle fire in any public place or thoroughfare without the consent of the Council.
6. Every Commercial fireplace, furnace, forge, oven or place wherein it is intended to use fire situate within a radius of five miles of the Kingston Parish Church shall be enclosed by brick, stone, or cement concrete walls or such other incombustible material and of such thickness as may be approved by the City Engineer, and every such fireplace, furnace, forge or oven shall when within a radius of ten feet from any building have a chimney with a hood of like material, the top of which shall be at least six feet above the highest part of the roof of any adjoining building in a direct line with such chimney, and every fireplace, furnace, forge or oven which does not conform to these Regulations whether erected before or after the coming into operation shall on notice to that effect being served on the owner or occupier of the land on which the same is situate, within fourteen days after such service, be made to comply with these Regulations or be removed.
7. If after erection of any chimney in conformity to these Regulations any person shall alter the same or erect or extend any building or structure without the consent of the Council the Council may order the removal or pulling down of such chimney, building or structure, and in default of such pulling down, may pull down the same.

8. Every owner or occupier of land within a radius of five miles from the Kingston Parish Church on which there is any fireplace, furnace, forge, oven or chimney shall keep the same clean at all times.

9. The Council may appoint any Officer or Officers to inspect lands for the purpose of these Regulations and every such Officer shall have free ingress and egress for such purposes.

If any person shall obstruct or assault any Officer in the discharge of his duties he shall be guilty of an offence against these Regulations.

TAKE NOTICE that you are required, within **THIRTY DAYS** after this Notice has been served upon you, to construct a proper fireplace upon your premises

in the Parish of _____ such fireplace to be enclosed by a brick or stone wall, not less than **NINE INCHES** thick, or by iron or other incombustible material, and to erect a chimney of brick, stone or iron, the top of which chimney shall be at least **SIX FEET** above the highest part of any adjoining roof or of any neighbouring roof within 10 feet in a direct line with such chimney.
