LIFEGUARD EXAM

The National Environment & Planning Agency (NEPA) will conduct the next annual Lifeguard Examinations in St. James as follows:

LOCATION: Doctor's Cave Beach, St. James

DATE: 9 – 13, April 2018

NOTE that registration commences at 8:30 a.m. and closes at 3:00 p.m. daily, except on Friday when registration closes at 12:00 noon.

To participate in the examination, candidates must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Be able to read and write
- Have attended and successfully passed a Jamaica Life Saving Society's (JLSS) Lifeguard Training course prior to the examination and be in possession of a valid and current JLSS Certificate
- Present valid photo I.D. - **Driver's Licence, National I.D., passport or a passport-size photograph certified by a Justice of the Peace**
- Pay the required Examination Fee

The Examination Fee is:

- \$1300.00 for renewal
- \$1500.00 for new candidate
- \$1000.00 for re-sit

The Lifeguard Licence Fee is \$2500.00 – To be paid by successful candidates for the Licence, which will be issued on the day of the exam.

Note that during the exam period, there **will be no lifeguard training**. ONLY persons in possession of a valid and current JLSS Certificate will be examined. Any queries regarding JLSS certification, please contact Mr. Stuart Fraser at 381-4136 or Commander John McFarlane at 919-2469.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

- **Fees must be paid on the designated vouchers at the Scotiabank branches conveniently located** prior to the date of the exam. A copy of the payment voucher must be taken to the exam.
- **Debit card** payments may also be made at the examination location.

NO CASH PAYMENT WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE EXAM SITE.
