LIFEGUARD EXAM

The National Environment & Planning Agency (NEPA) will conduct the next annual Lifeguard Examination in Kingston as follows:

LOCATION: University of Technology, St. Andrew

DATE: 29 June 2017

NOTE: Registration commences at 8:30 a.m. and closes at 3:00 p.m.

To participate in the examination, candidates must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Be able to read and write
- Have attended and successfully passed a lifeguard training course prior to the examination and be in possession of a valid and current Lifesaving Certificate
- Present valid photo I.D. - **Driver's Licence, National I.D., Passport, or a Passport sized photograph certified by a Justice of the Peace**
- Pay the required Examination Fee

The Examination Fee is:

- **\$800.00** for renewal
- **\$1000.00** for new candidate
- **\$500.00** for re-sit

The Lifeguard Licence Fee is \$2000.00 – To be paid by the successful candidates for the Licence, which will be issued on the day of the exam.

Note: During the exam period there **will be no lifeguard training**. **ONLY** persons in possession of a valid and current Lifeguard Certificate will be examined. For information on lifeguard training, contact the Royal Life Saving Society Jamaica (RLSSJ) or Mr. Norman Stuart Fraser at 381-4136.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

- **Fees must be paid using the designated vouchers at the branches of the Bank of Nova Scotia located in Kingston and St. Andrew or near you prior to the date of the exam. A copy of the payment voucher must be taken to the exam.**
- **Debit card** payments may also be made at the examination location.

NO CASH PAYMENT WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE EXAM SITE.
