LIFEGUARD EXAM

The National Environment & Planning Agency (NEPA) will conduct the next annual Lifeguard Examinations in St. James as follows:

LOCATION: Doctor's Cave Beach, St James

DATE: 03 - 07 April 2017

NOTE that registration commences at 8:30 a.m. and closes at 3:00 p.m. daily, except on Friday when it closes at 11:00 a.m.

To participate in the examination, candidates must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Be able to read and write
- Have attended and successfully passed a lifeguard training course prior to the examination and be in possession of a valid and current Lifeguard Certificate
- Present valid photo I.D. - **Driver's Licence, National I.D., passport or a passport size photograph certified by a Justice of the Peace**
- Pay the required Examination Fee

The Examination Fee is:

- **\$800.00** for renewal
- **\$1000.00** for new candidate
- **\$500.00** for re-sit

The Lifeguard Licence Fee is \$2000.00 – To be paid by the successful candidates for the Licence, which will be issued on the day of the exam.

Note that during the exam period **there will be no lifeguard training. ONLY** persons in possession of a valid and current Lifeguard Certificate will be examined. Any queries on lifeguard training, contact the JLSS or Mr Stuart Fraser at 381-4136

PAYMENT OPTIONS

- **Fees must be paid using the designated vouchers at the Scotiabank branches located in Montego Bay or near you** prior to the date of the exam. A copy of the payment voucher must be taken to the exam
- **Debit card** payments may also be made at the examination location.
