Topic: "Unpacking the urban planning nexus with tourism and sustainable development"

Registration date: November 8, 2024

Deadline for submission of posters: December 13, 2024

Suggested Themes:

Primary school (Grades 4-6)

- *Parks and Playgrounds for All!*

High school (Grades 7-9)

- *Building Green cities for the future*

High school (Grades 10-13)

- *"Green Urbanism: Where Sustainable Tourism Meets Urban Innovation"*

How to submit:

- Fill out the entry form provided on the <https://www.nepa.gov.jm/> website and agree to the Terms and Conditions
- Please indicate your Name(s), School and Grade Level at the bottom of your poster
- Digital designs should use a cloud storage service such as DropBox, SkyDrive or Google Drive

Rules:

1. Posters must follow the theme: *"Unpacking the Urban Planning Nexus with Tourism and Sustainable Development"* or any of the simpler themes provided. Creativity in interpreting the theme is encouraged,
2. Posters should be 11in. x 17in. (landscape or portrait).
3. Participants are welcome to use any art materials, including crayons, coloured pencils, markers, paints. However, a digital photo or scanned coloured copy of same should be submitted
4. Any digital tools can be used for creating and submitting a digital poster.
5. Posters will be judged on the following criteria: interpretation of the topic, Creativity and originality, Artistic quality and relevance to the theme.
6. NEPA and its partners reserves the right to disqualify any poster that does not meet the requirements specified in these instructions. Students will be penalized for Plagiarism (passing off another person's idea or work as your own).

Prizes:

- Prizes will be awarded to three (3) top students in each category:
 - 1st, 2nd and 3rd place students from the Primary school level (Grades 4 -6)
 - 1st, 2nd and 3rd place students from the High school level (Grades 7- 9)
 - 1st, 2nd and 3rd place students from the High school level (Grades 10-13)
- Each awardee will receive a cash prize, trophy and certificate of participation.
- The parent or teacher of the awardees will receive a gift basket token
- Other prizes include feature on limited edition Totes, newspaper feature and photos and accompanying news and press releases will be posted on NEPA's social medias and <https://www.nepa.gov.jm/>
- Participants not selected will receive a certification of participation.

Eligibility:

- Any registered Primary and High school students in Jamaica (Grades 4-13) are eligible to compete.
- Groups of **NO MORE THAN 3** persons are eligible to compete.

**Immediate relatives of the core planning team (NEPA and Stakeholders) are not eligible to participate in the World Town Planning Day Poster Competition.*
